Only 51.8%
of domestic violence victims
reported their most recent
incident to the police

Top three reasons
for **NOT** reporting to police

1. Fear of further violence
2. Embarrassment/shame
3. Perception that the incident was too trivial/unimportant

Victims were less likely to
report if they were pregnant or
experienced more than five
previous incidents of abuse
