However, there is something to be more thankful for, the coming of Jesus to redeem his people. Zechariah is bursting with thankfulness to God for salvation, redemption and rescue—all three mean the same idea—deliverance from slavery to sin and God's enemies.



But why is rescue important? Zechariah gives one answer and it is surprising, verse 74, God has rescued us to enable us to serve him without fear in holiness and righteousness. Zechariah is rejoicing in his newfound ability to serve God and all because of Jesus. The Christmas message is actually about how on earth do I receive this message of rescue in order to glorify God and serve him forever. This is our amazing message today.
