The Holy Spirit also helped create the man Jesus because the Ho-

ly Spirit is the creative power of God. The application for Christians today is remarkably simple, we are equipped to proclaim God's word by the power of the Spirit; he converts or recreates, he encourages and he gives us voice and he does all this by drawing us to the font of all inspiration- the word of God.

This is most beautifully shown in Jesus' defeat of Satan in Luke 4 where Jesus 'full of the Holy Spirit' rebuffs Satan by the power of the word of God. Jesus shows us the content of our message must be the same as his-the word of God. And so, our aim today is to follow Jesus' example- a complete understanding and reliance on God's word as the content of our proclamation even when conflict might arise.
