### How natural are natural disasters?

One of the conundrums for modern Christians is our understanding and explanation of natural disasters. We struggle to posit arguments answering the question, how natural are natural disasters?

We have a sovereign God and therefore nothing happens or exists outside of his power and knowledge. But we see tsunamis, earthquakes and bushfires killing and destroying Christians and non-Christians alike and struggle to cohere this with our view of a loving God.

This can be magnified when we read Scripture like in Psalm 29 where the God of nature is powerfully at work destroying whilst he also is powerfully at work leading Israel to yell 'glory' to God.



What is happening in both Psalm 29 and in nature? And how can we understand what God is doing and how we should be responding?
