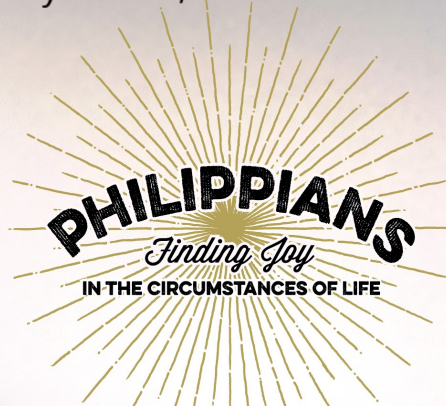
## **Philippians**
