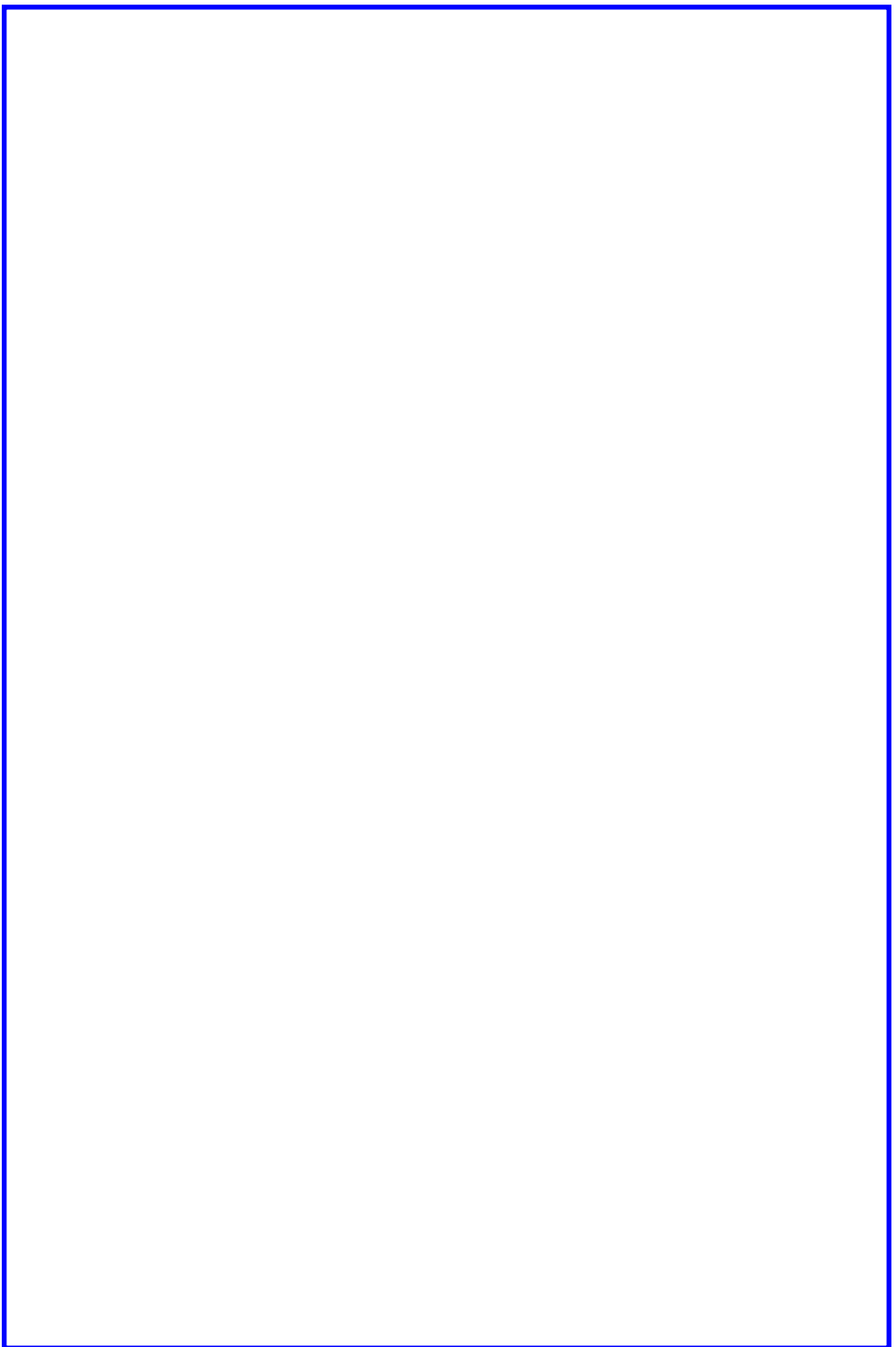
End of Year Kids Church
